# **ElevateDD Advocacy Platform Supports DSACO Families**

By now, you have likely heard about ElevateDD, an advocacy platform that will allow us to continue elevating the voices of people with developmental disabilities, elevating the needs of families, and elevating advocacy issues to leaders and decision makers. This is a new space for advocacy work that had been happening through DSACO.

For the past 40 years, DSACO has been advocating for and supporting people with Down syndrome and their families. This advocacy work has inspired programs like Learning Aid Ohio and Adult Literacy Ohio, which have extended to serve all people with developmental disabilities statewide. And while DSACO wants to grow in advocacy, it also wants to remain focused on the Down syndrome community.

"It has been a goal to grow this advocacy, and our Governing Board is excited to take this step by establishing the ElevateDD platform," said Kari Jones, President & CEO of ElevateDD.

ElevateDD advocacy supports those served through DSACO, Learning Aid Ohio, and Adult Literacy Ohio, and continues to advocate further for the needs of the developmental disability community. It will also collaborate with partners to educate decision makers regarding unmet and emerging needs.

"Over the years, we've earned the responsibility of shaping and leading programs that benefit not only our DSACO community, but people across Ohio with developmental disabilities," said Jones. "ElevateDD will continue this important work."

DSACO families and the developmental disability community will be the organization's driving force. "We listen to what they need and then elevate their voices to illuminate existing opportunities and launch innovative solutions," said Jones.

Every classroom is equipped with two certified educators and one classroom support specialist to foster academic enrichment, social-emotional growth, and assistance with behavioral and personal care needs. Additionally, students will enjoy complimentary one-way transportation home from the program each day.

DSACO's Summer Learning Academy is set to begin on Monday, June 10th, and will continue through Thursday, July 11th. The program operates exclusively from Monday to Thursday, spanning from 9 AM – 12PM.


